CANDY RULES

There seem to be rules for everything these days, we know. However, due to some injuries and a near serious accident in previous years' parades we must restrict the manner in which candy is delivered during the parade.

PLEASE DO NOT THROW CANDY FROM YOUR VEHICLE.

If you plan on distributing items during the parade, please have someone walk along beside your vehicle and either hand them out or toss them gently under-handed.

RULES APPLICABLE TO ALL MOUNTED ANIMAL ENTRIES

1. No stallions will be allowed in the parade.
2. Each entry, either single or group, is required to provide their own "pooper scooper" to follow each horse entry in the parade. The "pooper scoopers" are encouraged to register as parade entrants and become eligible for an award in their own category.
3. Any rider who is experiencing difficulty in controlling their horse is required to immediately dismount until the issue is resolved between horse and rider. If safety and control are re-established, the rider is permitted to re-mount and continue in the parade. If not the rider is required to remove the horse from the parade.
4. For all riders under the age of 13, a handler walking along with the horse entries is required for each entry with a ratio of no more than three entries for each handler.
5. Any parade official or those acting under instruction of the parade committee may evict/eliminate a rider from the parade at any time if any of the above rules are not followed. The rider must dismount and walk the animal in a controlled manner, or must leave the parade route.
